



13. Elf Earrings

Materials Required

- 4 x 1" head pins
- 2 x 2" eye pin
- 4 x 4mm green Chinese Crystal rondelle
- 2 x 12mm Chinese Crystal rondelle
- 2 x 8mm Glass Pearl
- 2 x 8mm Crystal Rondell
- 2 x 6x8mm Teardrop
- 2 x 3mm white pearls
- 1 PR earring wires



- Thread on head pin a 4mm green rondelle, turn a loop at the top of the pin. Repeat this on a second head pin.
- Open up the loop of the eye pin and thread on the two pins just created and close loop.
- Thread on eye pin a 12mm rondelle, 8mm pearl, crystal rondelle, teardrop (big end first) and lastly a 3mm pearl.
- Make a loop close to the beads and attach to the earring wire.

How to turn a circle:

1. Bend the wire at a right angle away from you as close to the bead as possible using the tip of the round nose pliers. Clip wire 1.5cm from the turn.
2. Grip the very tip of the wire in your round nose pliers about halfway up the pliers. (The diameter of the pliers where you grip determines the circle's size e.g. if you want a small circle grip with tip of the pliers, medium circle grip the pliers in the middle.)
3. Press downwards slightly and rotate the wire into a circle.
4. Let go, grasp the circle at the same place on the pliers and keep turning to close the circle. You can turn this circle again to make a double more secure circle.



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
