



14. 3 Ball Drops

Materials Required

- 2 x 5cm head pins
- 2 x 4cm head pins
- 2 x 3cm head pins
- 2 x 8mm red glass beads
- 2 x 8mm green glass beads
- 2 x 8mm clear glass beads
- 1 PR earring wires



- Thread onto a 5cm pin a green bead, turn a circle at the top of pin.
- Thread onto a 4cm pin a red bead, turn a circle at the top of the pin.
- Thread onto a 3cm pin a clear bead, turn a circle at the top of pin.
- With the earring wire hook facing to the left, open the circle and attach the red, clear and green beaded pins made above.
- Close the circle.
- Repeat the first 3 steps for the second earring.
- With earring hook facing to the right, open the circle and attach the green, clear and red beaded pins.
- Close the circle.

How to turn a circle:

1. Bend the wire at a right angle away from you as close to the bead as possible using the tip of the round nose pliers. Clip wire 1.5cm from the turn.
2. Grip the very tip of the wire in your round nose pliers about halfway up the pliers. (The diameter of the pliers where you grip determines the circle's size e.g. if you want a small circle grip with tip of the pliers, medium circle grip the pliers in the middle.)
3. Press downwards slightly and rotate the wire into a circle.
4. Let go, grasp the circle at the same place on the pliers and keep turning to close the circle. You can turn this circle again to make a double more secure circle.
