



19. Pudding Earrings

Materials Required

- 2 x 1 ½" head pin
- 2 x 6mm brown sequins
- 2 x 14mm Brown glass pearls
- 2 x 13mm Bead caps
- 4 x 6mm green sequins
- 2 x 4mm red bicones acrylic
- 1 PR Earring wires



- Thread onto a head pin, 1 x brown sequin, 1 x pearl, 1 x bead cap, 2 x green sequins and 1 x 4mm bicone.
- Cut pin to required length and turn into a circle.
- Attach to earring wire.
- Make a second one to match.

How to turn a circle:

1. Bend the wire at a right angle away from you as close to the bead as possible using the tip of the round nose pliers. Clip wire 1.5cm from the turn.
2. Grip the very tip of the wire in your round nose pliers about halfway up the pliers. (The diameter of the pliers where you grip determines the circle's size e.g. if you want a small circle grip with tip of the pliers, medium circle grip the pliers in the middle.)
3. Press downwards slightly and rotate the wire into a circle.
4. Let go, grasp the circle at the same place on the pliers and keep turning to close the circle. You can turn this circle again to make a double more secure circle.



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
