



## 21. Snowman Earrings

### Materials Required

- 2 x 12mm pearls
- 2 x 10mm pearls
- 2 x 2" eye pins
- 2 x 10mm black sequin
- 2 x 4mm black square beads
- 2 x 8mm crystal rondelles
- 2 x earring wires



### Tools required:

Round Nose Pliers

Wire Cutters

### Method:

Step 1: use a 1½" eye pin.

Step 2: thread on one 12mm pearl.

Step 3: thread on one 8mm crystal rondelles.

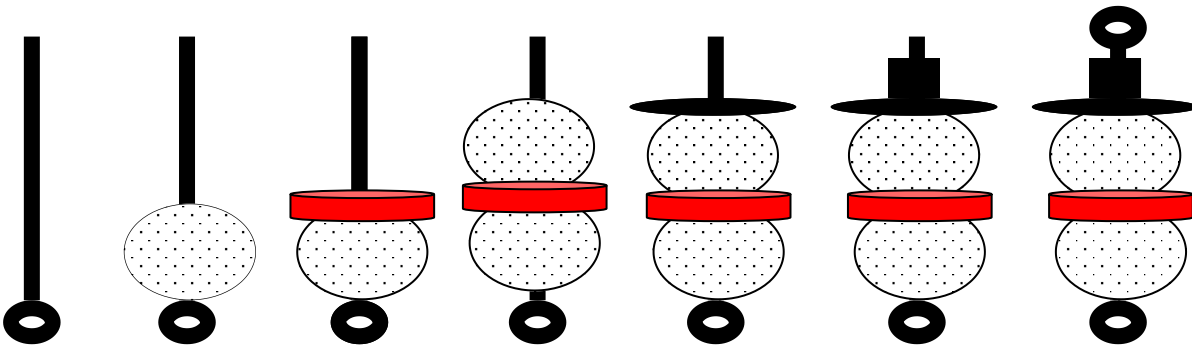
Step 4: thread on one 10mm pearl.

Step 5: thread on one 10mm black sequin.

Step 6: thread on one 4mm black square bead.

Step 7: turn a loop as instructed below adding the earring wire.

Repeat steps 1-7 to make the second earring.



### How to turn a circle:

1. Bend the wire at a right angle away from you as close to the bead as possible using the tip of the round nose pliers. Clip wire 1.5cm from the turn.
2. Grip the very tip of the wire in your round nose pliers about halfway up the pliers. (The diameter of the pliers where you grip determines the circle's size e.g. if you want a small circle grip with tip of the pliers, medium circle grip the pliers in the middle.)
3. Press downwards slightly and rotate the wire into a circle.
4. Let go, grasp the circle at the same place on the pliers and keep turning to close the circle. You can turn this circle again to make a double more secure circle.
