



## 22. Christmas Lights Green and Red

### Materials Required

- 4 x 1 ½" Head pins silver
- 4 x 4mm Jump Rings
- 2 x Three-hole spacer bar
- 2 x 8 x 6mm CD green teardrop
- 2 x 8 x 6mm CD red teardrop
- 4 x 6mm diamante rondelles
- 4 x 5mm crystal ab bicones
- 2 x 4mm red bicones
- 2 x 4mm green bicones.
- 1 PR earring wires



- On one head pin thread on 1 x red teardrop (through the small end first), 1 x 6mm rondelle, 1 x 4mm clear bicone, 1 x 4mm green bicone.
- Trim pin and turn a circle close to the bead.
- Use one jump ring to attach this pin to the end of the 3-hole spacer bar.
- On another head pin thread on 1 x green teardrop (through the small end first), 1 x 6mm rondelle, 1 x 4mm clear bicone, 1 x 4mm red bicone.
- Trim pin and turn a circle close to the bead.
- Use one jump ring to attach this pin to the opposite end of the 3-hole spacer bar.
- Attach the earring wire to this end of the spacer bar.
- Repeat steps for the second earring making sure that earring wires are facing in the opposite direction.

### How to turn a circle:

1. Bend the wire at a right angle away from you as close to the bead as possible using the tip of the round nose pliers. Clip wire 1.5cm from the turn.
2. Grip the very tip of the wire in your round nose pliers about halfway up the plies. The diameter of the pliers where you grip determines the circle's size e.g. if you want a small circle grip with tip of the pliers, medium circle grip the pliers in the middle.
3. Press downwards slightly and rotate the wire into a circle.
4. Let go, grasp the circle at the same place on the pliers and keep turning to close the circle. You can turn this circle again to make a double more secure circle.



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
