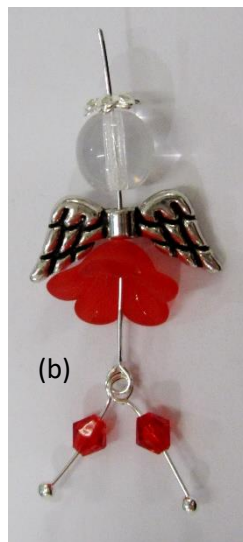
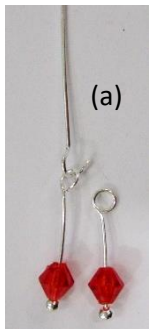




23. Dancing Angel Earring

Materials Required

- 4 x 1" ball pins
- 2 x 1 1/2" eye pins
- 4 x 4mm bicones
- 2 x Acrylic cup flowers
- 2 x wings
- 2 x 8mm clear round beads
- 1 x 9mm bead caps



- On each of the ball pins put on 1 x 4mm bicone.
- Turn a circle at the end of the pins.
- You now have 4 legs.
- Open eye of one eye pin and thread on the two legs as in picture (a). Close the eye.
- On the other end of the eye pin thread on 1 x flower (through the wide side first), wings, 1 x clear bead and 1 x bead cap, as in picture (b).
- Trim pin to length required and turn a circle at the top of the pin.
- Attach to earring wire.

How to turn a circle:

1. Bend the wire at a right angle away from you as close to the bead as possible using the tip of the round nose pliers. Clip wire 1.5cm from the turn.
2. Grip the very tip of the wire in your round nose pliers about halfway up the pliers. (The diameter of the pliers where you grip determines the circle's size e.g. if you want a small circle grip with tip of the pliers, medium circle grip the pliers in the middle.)
3. Press downwards slightly and rotate the wire into a circle.
4. Let go, grasp the circle at the same place on the pliers and keep turning to close the circle. You can turn this circle again to make a double more secure circle.
